

## **The William H. Hannon Foundation Supports Two Westchester Institutions: AMCS & Visitation Catholic School**

**November 2016/Santa Monica, CA** --The William H. Hannon Foundation has renewed its support of two important Westchester institutions, Visitation Catholic School (Visitation), founded in 1946, and Airport Marina Counseling Service (AMCS), founded in 1961. The Foundation contributed \$10,000 to student scholarships at Visitation and made a \$20,000 contribution to continue the “Hannon Immediate Intervention Program” at AMCS.

“My late uncle, William Hannon, our Foundation’s founder, supported both Visitation and AMCS when he established the William H. Hannon Foundation. His business and foundation offices were located in Westchester and he loved his role in building the community. He felt Visitation and AMCS were important to making Westchester a special place,” said Kathleen Hannon Aikenhead, President of the William H. Hannon Foundation and a board member of the Foundation since it was established in 1983.

Visitation Parish and School have launched a three-year enhancement project, which includes as one of its goals to provide tuition assistance for student applicants based on both need and active parish membership. AMCS provides affordable, community-based mental health services with a focus on the underserved and uninsured. During 2015, the Hannon Immediate Intervention program offered over 750 group therapy options to 79 clients.
