

William H. Hannon Foundation Continues Support for the Chancellor Scholarships at Loyola Marymount University

Santa Monica, CA (November 26, 2018): The William H. Hannon Foundation has continued its support of the Chancellor Scholarships at Loyola Marymount University (LMU) with a \$12,000 contribution to fund financial assistance for students from Jesuit prep schools attending the Jesuit university in Westchester. This brings the foundation's total contributions to this scholarship to \$145,000.

The Chancellor Scholarships are designed to help students from middle-income families who have attended Jesuit prep schools prior to coming to LMU. Recipients can receive up to \$12,000 per year for four years. The program began in April 1999 when then LMU Chancellor Patrick J. Cahalan, SJ, approached William Hannon asking for his financial support to establish the scholarship program.

"Fr. Cahalan was a good friend of my late uncle. He knew my uncle went to Loyola High School, and then, only because of financial help from Loyola University, was he able to attend and graduate during the Depression. My uncle never forgot that help, and as a Foundation we keep true to his spirit of providing scholarships for those seeking to attend LMU—just like he did," said James Hannon, Treasurer of the William H.
