



Mayfield Senior School Plans New Library

August, 2011: The William H. Hannon Foundation has made a \$160,000 grant to Mayfield Senior School in Pasadena to support the high school's "Faith in Our Future" campaign which will increase teaching space on campus by 38%, create a new library and technology center, new reception and administration offices and a new multi-purpose room at the all-girls school. The campaign is expected to raise \$13 million. Prior to the Foundation's Board of Directors deciding to support the campaign, Foundation President Kathleen Hannon Aikenhead and Foundation Treasurer Jim Hannon visited Mayfield Senior School for a first-hand briefing on the campaign.

The Foundation's gift will be recognized in the naming of the entrance area of the new library, which will be outfitted with soft furniture, a collaborative lounge and reading area. The area will also be used to display student art work. According to Rita McBride, Head of School, "We are thrilled to receive the support of the William H. Hannon Foundation to help create a learning and research environment that fosters our students' intellectual and spiritual growth."

"One of the areas of focus for our Foundation is Catholic elementary and secondary education. We are pleased to support Mayfield's efforts to improve its campus, which will provide important educational benefits for their students," said Aikenhead.
