South Bay Children's Health Center To Continue Dental Screenings at Twenty South Bay Schools

The William H. Hannon Foundation has renewed its past support of the South Bay Children's Health Center (SBCHC) in Redondo Beach. SBCHC provides a free oral health screening program at twenty South Bay elementary and middle schools. During the 2008-2009 fiscal year, 10,011 children were screened at the twenty school campuses. The Foundation's \$15,000 grant will provide support to underwrite the costs to provide preventive and restorative dental care to low and moderate income families and also purchase a new Stylus Easycare Fiber Optic instrument as well as an Optimix Mixing System.
