



Foundation Makes \$100,000 Pledge to the Venice Family Clinic for its Mar Vista Clinic Site

Santa Monica, CA (March, 2010)—The William H. Hannon Foundation has made a \$100,000 pledge, payable over four years, to the Venice Family Clinic (VFC) to support services at its Mar Vista Clinic site. VFC provides free, quality health care to people in need. VFC is the principal provider of free primary health care services to low-income, uninsured and homeless individuals in the communities of Santa Monica, Palms, Mar Vista, Culver City, Westchester, West Los Angeles, Marina del Rey and Venice. VFC is the largest free clinic in the country.

“Many of the areas served by VFC are places where my late uncle developed homes and helped to create vibrant communities. My uncle always believed that helping those less fortunate was a responsibility of those who have been blessed by success. One way that we can continue to carry out his wishes is to help organizations like VFC, which provide critical services to those in need,” said Kathleen Hannon Aikenhead, President of the William H. Hannon Foundation. Aikenhead is a niece of the late William Hannon and has served on the Foundation’s Board of Directors since its founding by her uncle in 1983.
